BRAD SELFGENERAL MANAGER

Brad Self enters his third season as the Mammoth's general manager and alternate governor since accepting the role in 2020. During his time at the helm of the Mammoth front office, Self has landed several large free agent signings and trades, including deals to acquire forwards Zed Williams and Connor Robinson en route to assembling the proper pieces to help the organization capture the 2022 NLL Championship, its first since 2006.

Prior to his current role, Self served as the organization's assistant general manager and oversaw personnel decisions and front office business alongside Mammoth Head Coach Pat Coyle during the 2019-20 campaign. Self initially joined the organization as the team's youth lacrosse development manager in 2018, partnering with youth lacrosse programs in Colorado and interacting with youth athletes during camps, clinics and grassroots initiatives.

Self's professional box lacrosse career spanned 13 years, beginning with the Ottawa Rebel in 2002-03 and ending with the Colorado Mammoth in 2018-19. Selected by the Buffalo Bandits in the second round (18th overall) of the 2001 NLL Draft, Self spent

most of his career – five seasons (2012-16) – with the Rochester Knighthawks, during which time he became a three-time NLL Champion (2012-14), the 2016 NLL Transition Player of the Year and a 2016 NLL All-Pro. Self spent four full seasons over two playing stints (2004-05, 2017-19) with the Mammoth, initially joining the team as a free agent in 2004, then returning in 2017 after being acquired in a trade with Buffalo.

Playing on the world stage, Self represented Canada with the national team at the World Indoor Lacrosse Championships in 2015, where the team captured gold. The Peterborough, Ontario native also played with the Peterborough Lakers Senior A lacrosse team in the MSL for 13 seasons (2003-07, 2009, 2011-17), winning the Gene Dopp Memorial Trophy as Top Rookie in the MSL in 2002 and hoisting Mann Cups with the Lakers in 2004, 2012 and 2017. During parts of his NLL career, Self played professional hockey in Germany for four seasons (2007-2011).

Brad and wife Alicia have two children: Coleman and Stella.



PAT COYLE ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER AND HEAD COACH

Pat Coyle enters his third season as the Mammoth's assistant general manager. This season also represents Coyle's fifth full season as head coach and his ninth season coaching the Mammoth overall. After serving as the organization's general manager since the 2018 season, Coyle transitioned his focus to coaching in July of 2020 as Brad Self was named general manager.

After leading the team to a 7-6 record during the shortened 2019-20 NLL season, Coyle saw a majority of his squad return for a triumphant run in 2021-22. Despite finishing the regular season 10-8 and in third place of the West Conference, Coyle led his group to a 5-2 record in the postseason to help capture the organization's second NLL Championship and first since 2006. Eliminating the Calgary Roughnecks in the Quarterfinals, besting the San Diego Seals in a best-of-three West Conference Finals before upsetting the league's favorite to earn the honors in the Buffalo Bandits in a Game 3 showdown at KeyBank Center, Coyle got the best out his players while continuing to build a championship culture.

Most recently coaching the team to a secondstraight appearance in the NLL Finals, Colorado again returns as a contender in 2023-24 under his experienced guidance. A Mammoth player from 2005-2008, Coyle was named to the Mammoth's All-Decade Team in 2012. Coyle was the 2002 NLL Defensive Player of the Year in the inaugural season of the award. A five-time champion in his 12-year playing career, Coyle hoisted the Champion's Cup four times with the Toronto Rock (1999, 2000, 2002-03) and once with the Mammoth (2006).

Coyle was inducted into the Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 2017. In 2014, Coyle became the first defenseman in league history to be inducted into the NLL Hall of Fame.





JASON BISHOP OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Jason Bishop enters his third season with the Mammoth, having joined the coaching staff in October 2021 and helping the team capture its 2021-22 NLL Championship. In his two seasons on the Mammoth bench, Colorado has managed to find its way to the NLL Finals, as the offensive coordinator continues to challenge and motivate top-tier talent in Zed Williams, Connor Robinson and company. Able to get the best out of his group, Bishop helped transform the Mammoth's reputation for being known as a defense-first group to being a legitimate threat in transition and five-on-five sets.

Prior to his promotion, Bishop served as the organization's western scout for five seasons, regularly providing scouting reports from the greater BC area, scouting upcoming opponents and providing video breakdown for team personnel and front office staff. In more than 20 years behind the bench in various capacities and

Canadian lacrosse programs, Bishop has helped lead many Canadian lacrosse teams to provincial and national championships, most recently spending time as the Offensive Coordinator for the Sr. A Coquitlam Adanacs last summer. He's also spent the last three active lacrosse seasons serving as Offensive Coordinator of the Jr. A Coquitlam Adanacs, alongside Mammoth Head Coach Pat Coyle.

The duo has helped the team compete in three Minto Cup appearances and captured the elusive championship victory in 2018. The former defenseman spent a majority of his Jr. and Sr. career playing as a defenseman with the Nanaimo Timbermen (WLA and WCSLA). Bishop competed for the Presidents Cup in 1992 with Nanaimo and played in the 1995 Mann Cup game with the Sr. New Westminster Salmonbellies.



DAN MACRAE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Dan MacRae enters his first season as defensive coordinator for the Mammoth after accepting the role in July of 2023. The Rochester Institute of Technology graduate assumes his new role with several seasons of coaching experience to his name, most recently spending the past three seasons coaching the Burlington Blaze Jr. A squad of the Ontario Junior Lacrosse League (OJLL) after representing the club as a player from 2007-09.

Coaching the squad to a 19-7 regular season record en route to helping the franchise secure its first national title. Recently retiring from professional play in the summer of 2023, MacRae logged 119 points (29g, 90a), 850 loose balls, 197 caused turnovers and 108 penalty minutes during his 12-year career with the Calgary Roughnecks

and New York Riptide. Adding seven points (1g, 6a), 92 loose balls, 25 caused turnovers and 21 penalty minutes in 25 career postseason games played, MacRae helped Calgary secured its most recent NLL Championship in 2019, chipping in three points (1g, 2a), 19 loose balls and six caused turnovers in four playoff appearances.



JOEL RAETHER HEAD OF SPORTS PERFORMANCE

Joel Raether has been with the Mammoth organization since 2007, working with the players to improve conditioning, nutrition and on-field performance and recently getting the team over the championship hump after seeing the team capture the league-best honors during the 2021-22 campaign.

An integral part of the team, in 2018, Raether received the Mammoth's President's Award: the team's highest honor recognizing the highest standard of excellence. Raether also serves as the Director of Sport Performance at Authentic Performance Center in Denver, Colorado. He served as the Education Programs Coordinator for the National Strength and Conditioning Association from 2009-2011.

Having coached and trained athletes of all levels, Raether's coaching career includes stints as the assistant strength and conditioning coach for the University of Denver from 2002-2009 and the University of Nebraska Kearney from 2000-2002.

Raether earned his bachelor's and master's degree in exercise science from the University of Nebraska Kearney and is a certified strength and conditioning specialist with distinction (CSCS*D) by the National Strength and Conditioning Association. Raether has co-authored books and has published numerous peer reviewed articles and popular literature contributions, as well as training DVDs. He is a highly sought-after presenter who has presented nationally and internationally on sports performance. Raether is also the co-founder of Performance Sandbag Training Systems (PST).

NLL AWARDS



2003 Most Valuable Player

Gary Gait's historic first season in Denver showed Colorado fans exactly why he is considered to be the best player in National Lacrosse League history. Gait carried the Mammoth in its inaugural season, smashing the single-season scoring record with 61 goals. He added 35 assists to finish third in overall league scoring with 96 points and was the centerpiece of the Mammoth offense that finished second in league scoring.



2003 Rookie of the Year

Brian Langtry quickly endeared himself to fans in Denver by scoring the overtime game-winner against the Toronto Rock in the Colorado Mammoth's first ever game on Jan. 3, 2003. He continued to delight fans of the fledging Mammoth during the 2003 season with his deadly shooting and flery on-field persona. Langtry racked up 28 goals and 34 assists to place third on the team in scoring and led all NLL rookies with 62 points.



2004 Sportsmanship Award

Mammoth captain Gary Gait, who led the NLL with 55 goals and five game-winning goals, served just four penalties for eight penalty minutes in 16 games. The Mammoth was the third-least penalized team this season, averaging just 18.75 penalty minutes per game.



2004 Goaltender of the Year

Gee Nash was named the National Lacrosse League's top goaltender after posting a career-high 11 wins and backstopping his team to the league's best record. In his fifth NLL season Nash recorded a league-best .790 save percentage and posted the third-best goals against average (10.68) among regular starting goaltenders.



2005 Sportsmanship Award

Gary Gait won the Sportsmanship Award for the second consecutive season in 2005 after retiring as the National Lacrosse League's all-time leading scorer. Gait served just two penalties for four penalty minutes in 16 games, while finishing ninth in league scoring with 81 points. The Mammoth was the fourth-least penalized team in 2005, averaging 23.25 penalty minutes per game.



2008 Sportsmanship Award

The Mammoth's Dan Carey deservingly won the NLL 2008 Sportsmanship Award. The left-handed forward has played three seasons for the Mammoth and in his 43 career games; Carey has accumulated only 11 penalty minutes, none in 2008. Before suffering a season-ending injury in 2008, Carey scored 22 goals and 27 assists in 11 games. Admired by teammates and opponents alike, Carey was named to the 2008 All-Star team. The Mammoth was the 4th least penalized team in the National Lacrosse League in 2008, averaging 20.56 penalty minutes per game.



2012 Most Valuable Player

John Grant Jr. rewrote the NLL record books, setting a new single-season points record (116) despite missing two games. His 50 goals were tops in the NLL, and his 19 power-play assists were second-most. Grant scored his 500th career goal and recorded his 1000th career point and 1000th career loose ball. He was a three-time NLL Player of the Month and four-time NLL Offensive Player of the Week.

2012 Rookie of the Year

Adam Jones, the third overall pick in the 2011 NLL Entry Draft, led all rookies in points (76) and assists (47). Both were franchise rookie records, as was his goal total (29). Jones was a three-time NLL Rookie of the Week and two-time NLL Rookie of the Month. He was the team's third-leading scorer.



2015 Transition Player of the Year

Joey Cupido enjoyed a breakout season in 2015, leading all defensemen in goals (16) and points (31). He topped the National Lacrosse League with 40 caused turnovers while his .372 shooting percentage was best among all players league-wide who scored nine or more goals. Cupido's four short-handed tallies were the most among defensemen, and one shy of the league-leader.



2016 NLL Air Canada 'Wingman of the Year'

Callum Crawford tied an NLL single-season record with 83 assists in 2016, and was honored for his playmaking ability and aerial athleticism around the crease. The forward – in his first season with the Mammoth – registered five-plus assists eight times, in cluding a nine-assist output against Buffalo in January which tied for the most by a player in a game in 2016. His 32 goals tied a career-high, and his 115 points were one shy of the team's single-season record.



2017 Goaltender of the Year

Dillon Ward, in his fourth year with the Mammoth, enjoyed a remarkable seven-game stretch in 2017, boasting a save percentage of .800 or better in every outing. He anchored a defense that held its opponents to single-digit goals in four straight games. Ward finished the 2017 campaign second in save percentage (.793) and in goals-against-average (10.89).



2018 Transition Player of the Year

Joey Cupido, in his seventh season with the Mammoth, was first in goals scored (16) and second in points scored (27) by NLL defensemen, posting the second-most shorthanded goals (5) in the NLL. Cupido's shooting percentage (.390) was the third highest in the NLL.



2018 Executive of the Year

Matt Hutchings is the Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of Kroenke Sports & Entertainment. Hutchings received the award for his role as Governor of the Colorado Mammoth. Under Hutchings' leadership, Mammoth staff increased revenue by 7.8% and increased paid tickets by 3% year-over-year. Hutchings also oversaw the Mammoth's staffing and significant team changes in 2018.


